





Attach the DWF4585X backer plate to the uprights at the desired height with the legs spread sufficiently to straddle the simulator. When assembling the stands for the left and right displays set the legs closer together to prevent the feet from stepping on each other.

Finish by inserting the caps to the top of the uprights and securing with the H2-1 bolt and W2 washer.

When mounting the TV to the brackets, first check the available depth of the screw hole on the back of the TV and compare that to the length of the screw you intend to use. Use washers or spacers as needed to prevent the screw from going too far into the TV.

WARNING!

Due to the variety of displays/TVs that may be used with this stand, please make sure the stand is stable after mounting the displays. If you feel the stand may fall over accidentally, please take steps to anchor it to your rig.
